Noticing life messages "in old familiar signs or those born in 2020" wherever they are to be found can be helpful in discovering the sometimes-hidden keys to the life to which God calls us.







We live in an age when messages are forced upon us with ever greater intensity and seductiveness. We are bombarded by volumes of high-powered advertising, such that few of us can be aware of the ways in which we are influenced. We risk the possibility of losing touch with either the presence or the meaning of important life signs. Sometimes it is only in looking back that we notice that we have changed.

Driving along many major thoroughfares in this country, we are often literally walled in by myriads of billboards, each of which reflects the attempt to persuade the consumer to believe whatever the sign says about a product, place, convenience, site, or even rest!

There are many signs that we encounter each day! Whether it is a visible sign or a "gut feeling" sign – signs are everywhere in our life.

### Awareness of your own personal signs – those by which we live and to which we instinctively respond!

**OPEN 24 HOURS A DAY** The sign of the compulsive giver

**DANGER** The ever-present sign of the habitual risk taker

**WRONG WAY** The sign of the moralist

**PRIVATE – NO TRESPASSING** The sign of the introvert



These signs are not to be taken more seriously than they deserve. They are offered with the hope that you may grow more aware of the life signs by which you live.

In today's world, we see signs that have become part of our daily life with heightened awareness! A whole new vocabulary of signage and seriousness.

# Pain is, of itself, evil and ought to be removed as quickly as possible

The expectation that suffering can be removed frustrates the hurting person and obscures exploration of the meaning that suffering has in human life. Suffering has its own unique power-filled way to call the hurting person to reach beyond the comfortable places of life and to reach into undiscovered possibilities.

#### New is better

To walk through life with the belief that nothing lasts and that replacing is better than keeping has brought us to the crisis of the environment which is all too apparent today. It has also brought us to a casual approach to relationships that devalue the sacredness of persons and the connectedness of all life on the planet.

This approach to life leads some of us to believe that if we can find the right guru, software or psychiatrist, we will never have to live with uncertainty. Yet, uncertainty is inseparable from the human journey to the experience of wisdom. Uncertainties begin to reveal glimpses of possible new directions.

## Power is measured by the degree of control we have over things and persons around us

It is becoming increasingly evident to large segments of the human family that the true power in the universe lies not outside the human person in possessions and wealth, but inside the human person.
